 - 3 SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS.
- 4 (a) AMENDMENTS.—After the date of the enactment
- 5 of this Act the following provisions of title XIV of the Pub-
- 6 lie Health Service Act ("the Safe Drinking Water Act")
- 7 and all references to such provisions shall cease to apply:

1	(1) Subclauses (III) and (IV) of section
2	1414(b)(3)(C), relating to quantifiable and nonquan-
3	tifiable costs likely to occur solely as a result of com-
4	pliance with a maximum contaminant level and the
5	incremental costs and benefits associated with each
6	alternative maximum contaminant level.

- (2) Paragraph (6) of section 1412(b), relating to additional health risk reduction and cost considerations.
- (3) Paragraph (15) of section 1412(b), relating to variance technologies.
- 12 (4) Paragraph (4) of section 1413(a), relating 13 to State primary enforcement authority to permit 14 variances or exemptions, or both, from the require-15 ments of its drinking water regulations.
 - (5) Section 1415, relating to variances.
- 17 (6) Section 1416, relating to exemptions.
- 18 (7) Section 1418, relating to interim monitoring 19 relief authority.
- 20 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There 21 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as may be 22 necessary to carry out this Act.
