AN ACT

To direct the United States Sentencing Commission to provide sentencing enhancement for offenses against property at national cemeteries.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Veterans' Cemetery
- 3 Protection Act of 1997".
- 4 SEC. 2. SENTENCING FOR VANDALISM AT NATIONAL CEME-
- 5 TERIES.
- 6 (a) General Rule.—Pursuant to its authority
- 7 under section 994 of title 28, United States Code, the
- 8 United States Sentencing Commission shall review and
- 9 amend the sentencing guidelines to provide a sentencing
- 10 enhancement for any offense against any property of a na-
- 11 tional cemetery—
- 12 (1) by at least 4 levels if the offense involves
- the willful injury to or depredation against such
- 14 property, and
- 15 (2) by at least 6 levels if the offense involves
- the knowing theft, conversion, or unlawful sale or
- disposition of such property.
- 18 (b) Commission Duty.—In carrying out subsection
- 19 (a), the Sentencing Commission shall ensure that the sen-
- 20 tences, guidelines, and policy statements for offenders con-
- 21 victed of offenses described in subsection (a) are appro-
- 22 priately severe and reasonably consistent with other rel-
- 23 evant directives and with other guidelines.
- (c) Definition.—For the purposes of this section,
- 25 the term "national cemetery" means a cemetery in the Na-
- 26 tional Cemetery System established under section 2400 of

- 1 title 38 and a cemetery under the jurisdiction of the Sec-
- 2 retary of the Army, the Secretary of the Navy, the Sec-
- 3 retary of the Air Force, or the Secretary of the Interior.
