## A BILL

To amend the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949 to authorize donation of surplus Federal law enforcement canines to their handlers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION TO DONATE SURPLUS LAW**  
4 **ENFORCEMENT CANINES TO THEIR HAN-**  
5 **DLERS.**

6 Section 203 of the Federal Property and Administra-  
7 tive Services Act of 1949 (40 U.S.C. 484) is amended by  
8 adding at the end the following:

1       “(r) The head of a Federal agency having control of  
2 a canine that has been used by a Federal agency in the  
3 performance of law enforcement duties and that has been  
4 determined to be surplus property may donate the canine  
5 to an individual who was responsible for handling the ca-  
6 nine in the performance of those duties.”.
