## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, with respect to the penalty for the rape of juveniles in prison.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Juvenile Rape in Pris-  
5       on Protection Act of 1997”.

6       **SEC. 2. PENALTY FOR RAPE OF JUVENILES IN PRISON.**

7       (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 109A of title 18, United  
8       States Code, is amended by adding at the end the follow-  
9       ing:

1 **“§ 2249. Penalty for rape of juveniles in prison**

2 “Whoever, having attained the age of 21 years, vio-  
3 lates section 2241 shall, if the victim is a Federal prisoner  
4 who has not attained the age of 18 years, be sentenced  
5 to life in prison.”.

6 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections  
7 at the beginning of chapter 109A of title 18, United States  
8 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new  
9 item:

“2249. Penalty for rape of juveniles in prison.”.
