## A BILL

To amend the Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments of 1984 to repeal the sunset of the Environmental Protection Agency Office of Ombudsman, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       That section 2002 of the Hazardous and Solid Waste  
4       Amendments of 1984 (42 U.S.C. 6917) is amended—

5               (1) IN GENERAL.—42 U.S.C. 6917(d) is hereby  
6       repealed.

7               (2) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—The Office of Om-  
8       budsman heretofore established by 42 U.S.C. 6917,

1 within the Environmental Protection Agency Office  
2 of Solid Waste and Emergency Response shall issue  
3 a report to the Congress on the status of health and  
4 environmental concerns addressed by Ombudsman  
5 cases. Such report shall include recommendations for  
6 improvements to the hazardous waste programs for  
7 which the Environmental Protection Agency and to  
8 the extent appropriate, the Agency for Toxic Sub-  
9 stances and Disease Registry (ATSDR) are respon-  
10 sible.

11 (3) STRUCTURE.—The Environmental Protec-  
12 tion Agency shall facilitate structuring the Office of  
13 Ombudsman consistent with the American Bar Asso-  
14 ciation’s Model Ombudsman Statute.
