 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Dairy Promotion Fair-
- 5 ness Act".

SEC. 2. FUNDING OF DAIRY PROMOTION AND RESEARCH
PROGRAM.
(a) Declaration of Policy.—Section 110(b) of
the Dairy Production Stabilization Act of 1983 (7 U.S.C.
4501(b)) is amended in the first sentence—
(1) by inserting after "commercial use" the fol-
lowing: "and on imported dairy products"; and
(2) by striking "products produced in the
United States." and inserting "products.".
(b) DEFINITIONS.—Section 111 of the Dairy Produc-
tion Stabilization Act of 1983 (7 U.S.C. 4502) is amend-
ed—
(1) in subsection (k), by striking "and" at the
end;
(2) in subsection (l), by striking the period at
the end and inserting a semicolon; and
(3) by adding at the end the following:
"(m) the term 'imported dairy product' means
any dairy product that is imported into the United
States, including dairy products imported into the
United States in the form of—
((1) milk and cream and fresh and dried
dairy products;
"(2) butter and butterfat mixtures;
"(3) cheese; and
"(4) casein and mixtures; and

1	"(n) the term 'importer' means a person that
2	imports an imported dairy product into the United
3	States.".
4	(c) Contingent Representation of Importers
5	ON BOARD.—Section 113(b) of the Dairy Production Sta-
6	bilization Act of 1983 (7 U.S.C. 4504(b)) is amended—
7	(1) by designating the first through ninth sen-
8	tences as paragraphs (1) through (5) and para-
9	graphs (7) through (10) , respectively;
10	(2) in paragraph (2) (as so designated), by
11	striking "Members" and inserting "Except as pro-
12	vided in paragraph (6), the members"; and
13	(3) by inserting after paragraph (5) (as so des-
14	ignated) the following:
15	"(6) Importers.—If representation of import-
16	ers of imported dairy products is required on the
17	Board by another law or a treaty to which the
18	United States is a party, the Secretary shall appoint
19	not more than two members who are representatives
20	of importers. The members appointed under this
21	paragraph shall be in addition to the total number
22	of members appointed under paragraph (2) and
23	shall be appointed from nominations submitted by
24	importers under such procedures as the Secretary
25	determines to be appropriate.".

1	(d) Importer Assessment.—Section 113(g) of the
2	Dairy Production Stabilization Act of 1983 (7 U.S.C.
3	4504(g)) is amended—
4	(1) by designating the first through fifth sen-
5	tences as paragraphs (1) through (5) , respectively;
6	and
7	(2) by adding at the end the following:
8	"(6) Importers.—
9	"(A) IN GENERAL.—The order shall pro-
10	vide that each importer of imported dairy prod-
11	ucts shall pay an assessment to the Board in
12	the manner prescribed by the order.
13	"(B) RATE.—The rate of assessment on
14	imported dairy products shall be determined in
15	the same manner as the rate of assessment per
16	hundredweight or the equivalent of milk.
17	"(C) VALUE OF PRODUCTS.—For the pur-
18	pose of determining the assessment on imported
19	dairy products under subparagraph (B), the
20	value to be placed on imported dairy products
21	shall be established by the Secretary in a fair
22	and equitable manner.".
23	(e) Records.—Section 113(k) of the Dairy Produc-
24	tion Stabilization Act of 1983 (7 U.S.C. 4504(k)) is

amended in the first sentence by striking "person receiv-

- 1 ing" and inserting "importer of imported dairy products,
- 2 each person receiving".
