A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Secret Tobacco Give-
5 away Repeal Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF TOBACCO INDUSTRY SETTLEMENT**

2 **CREDIT.**

3 Subsection (k) of section 9302 of the Balanced Budg-
