## A BILL

To amend the Balanced Budget Act of 1997 to provide for prostate cancer screening benefits as of January 1, 1998.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Medicare Prostate  
5 Cancer Screening Act of 1997”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROVISION OF PROSTATE CANCER SCREENING**

2 **BENEFITS AS OF JANUARY 1, 1998.**

3 Section 4103(e) of the Balanced Budget Act of 1997  
4 (Public Law 105–33) is amended by striking “January 1,  
5 2000” and inserting “January 1, 1998”.
