A BILL

To prohibit the use of funds appropriated to the Department of Defense from being used for the conduct of offensive operations by United States Armed Forces against the Republic of Iraq for the purpose of obtaining compliance by Iraq with United Nations Security Council resolutions relating to inspection and destruction of weapons of mass destruction in Iraq by the United Nations, unless such operations are specifically authorized by law.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF USE ON DEPARTMENT OF DE-**
2 **FENSE FUNDS FOR CONDUCT OF OFFENSIVE**
3 **OPERATIONS BY UNITED STATES ARMED**
4 **FORCES AGAINST THE REPUBLIC OF IRAQ.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—None of the funds appropriated
6 or otherwise available to the Department of Defense may
7 be obligated or expended for the conduct of offensive oper-
8 ations by United States Armed Forces against the Repub-
9 lic of Iraq for the purpose of obtaining compliance by Iraq
10 with United Nations Security Council resolutions relating
11 to inspection and destruction of weapons of mass destruc-
12 tion in Iraq by the United Nations.

13 (b) EXCEPTION.—The prohibition against the con-
14 duct of offensive operations described in subsection (a)
15 shall not apply if such operations are specifically author-
16 ized by a law enacted after the date of the enactment of
17 this Act.
