Mr. FRANK of Massachusetts introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To amend Public Law 96–87 to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to acquire certain lands for inclusion in the Frederick Law Olmstead National Historic Site.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ACQUISITION OF LANDS FOR FREDERICK LAW**
4 **OLMSTEAD NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE.**

5 Section 201 of Public Law 96–87 (93 Stat. 664; 16
6 U.S.C. 461 note) is amended by adding at the end the
7 following:

8 “(d)(1) Notwithstanding subsection (c), in order to
9 preserve and maintain the historic setting of the Site, the

1 Secretary may acquire, by donation only, lands and inter-
2 ests in lands that are situated adjacent to the Site and
3 owned by the Brookline Conservation Land Trust (a non-
4 profit corporation established under the laws of the State
5 of Massachusetts).

6 “(2) Lands acquired under this subsection shall be
7 included in and maintained and managed as part of the
8 Site.”.
