## A BILL

To provide for the liquidation or reliquidation of certain  
entries.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIQUIDATION OR RELIQUIDATION OF CERTAIN**  
4 **ENTRIES.**

5 (a) LIQUIDATION OR RELIQUIDATION OF ENTRIES.—  
6 Notwithstanding sections 514 and 520 of the Tariff Act  
7 of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514 and 1520), or any other provi-  
8 sion of law, the United States Customs Service shall, not  
9 later than 90 days after the date of the enactment of this  
10 Act, liquidate or reliquidate those entries made at Los An-  
11 geles, California, and New Orleans, Louisiana, which are

1 listed in subsection (c), in accordance with the final deci-  
 2 sion of the International Trade Administration of the De-  
 3 partment of Commerce for shipments entered between Oc-  
 4 tober 1, 1984, and December 14, 1987 (case number A-  
 5 274-001).

6 (b) PAYMENT OF AMOUNTS OWED.—Any amounts  
 7 owed by the United States pursuant to the liquidation or  
 8 reliquidation of an entry under subsection (a) shall be paid  
 9 by the Customs Service within 90 days after such liquida-  
 10 tion or reliquidation.
