## A BILL

To nullify a certain regulation regarding the operation of  
the Organ Procurement and Transplantation Network.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. FINAL RULE ON ORGAN PROCUREMENT AND**  
4                       **TRANSPLANTATION NETWORK; NULLIFICA-**  
5                       **TION OF CERTAIN PROVISION.**

6       With respect to the final rule relating to the Organ  
7 Procurement and Transplantation Network that on April  
8 2, 1998, was published in the Federal Register (63 FR  
9 16296), the provision established as section 121.8(a)(3)(i)  
10 of title 42, Code of Federal Regulations (relating to the

- 1 allocation of organs among transplant candidates in order
- 2 of decreasing medical urgency status), has no legal effect.
- 3 The preceding sentence applies on and after the effective
- 4 date of such final rule.
