## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to provide that a person sentenced by a court-martial to confinement for life may not be granted parole until the person has been confined for at least 30 years.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Military Parole Limita-
- 5 tion Act of 1998".

### SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON PAROLE FOR PERSONS SENTENCED 2 BY A COURT-MARTIAL TO CONFINEMENT FOR 3 LIFE. 4 Section 952 of title 10, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new sub-5 section: 6 "(c) An offender serving a sentence of confinement 7 for life for an offense committed after the date of the enactment of this subsection may not be granted parole be-9 fore the completion of at least 30 years of such confine-
