Mr. RIGGS (for himself and Mr. HERGER) introduced the following bill; which
was referred to the Committee on Resources

A BILL

To reauthorize and amend the Trinity River Basin Fish
and Wildlife Management Act of 1984.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Trinity River Basin
5 Fish and Wildlife Restoration Reauthorization Act of
6 1998”.

7 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF TRINITY RIVER BASIN FISH**
8 **AND WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT ACT OF 1984.**

9 (a) **AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**—Section
10 4(a) of the Trinity River Basin Fish and Wildlife Manage-

1 ment Act of 1984 (Public Law 98–541; 98 Stat. 2721)

2 is amended—

3 (1) in paragraph (1)—

4 (A) by striking “October 1, 1998” and in-
5 serting “October 1, 2006”; and

6 (B) by striking the dollar amount and in-
7 serting “\$80,000,000”; and

8 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “thirteen-year
9 period” and inserting “21-year period”.

10 (b) EXPENDITURES IN ACCORDANCE WITH TASK
11 FORCE PRIORITIES, POLICIES, AND PROCESSES.—Section
12 2 of such Act is amended by adding at the end the follow-
13 ing:

14 “(c) The Secretary shall ensure that all expenditures
15 of Federal funds for the purposes of the management pro-
16 gram formulated under subsection (a) are made in a man-
17 ner consistent with such priorities, policies, and technical
18 and fiscal review processes as are established by the Task
19 Force.”.

20 (b) CONTRACTOR EXPENDITURES FOR ADMINISTRA-
21 TIVE, INDIRECT, AND OVERHEAD COSTS.—Section 2 of
22 such Act is further amended by adding at the end the fol-
23 lowing:

24 “(d)(1) The amount expended by a contractor for ad-
25 ministrative, indirect, and overhead costs, in carrying out

1 a contract of less than \$5,000 that is funded under the
2 management program may not exceed 20 percent of the
3 total amount of Federal funds obligated or expended
4 under the contract.

5 “(2) The Secretary shall require that any bid or pro-
6 posal for a contract of \$5,000 or more to be funded under
7 the management program, and any such contract, shall
8 separately identify the amount that is authorized to be ex-
9 pended by a contractor under the contract for administra-
10 tive, indirect, and overhead costs.”.

11 (c) PERIODIC EVALUATIONS OF TRINITY RIVER
12 BASIN FISH AND WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM.—
13 Section 2 of such Act is further amended by adding at
14 the end the following:

15 “(e) No later than October 1, 2000, and every 3 years
16 thereafter, the Task Force shall—

17 “(1) evaluate the management program formu-
18 lated under section 2(a) and determine the results
19 achieved by the management program;

20 “(2) submit a report to the Congress on the
21 findings and conclusions of the evaluation that con-
22 tains specific recommendations for any required im-
23 provements in the management program; and

24 “(3) initiate such changes as may be required
25 in policies, procedures, and activities of the manage-

1 ment program to assure that the purposes and re-
2 quirements of this Act are achieved.”.

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
