## A BILL

To designate the Federal building located at 310 New Bern Avenue in Raleigh, North Carolina, as the “Terry Sanford Federal Building”.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Terry Sanford Com-  
3 memoration Act of 1998”.

4 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

5 Congress makes the following findings:

6 (1) Terry Sanford served the State of North  
7 Carolina and the Nation with enthusiasm, bravery,  
8 and distinction in many important ways, including—

9 (A) as a paratrooper in World War II;

10 (B) as an agent with the Federal Bureau  
11 of Investigation;

12 (C) as a North Carolina State senator;

13 (D) as Governor of North Carolina;

14 (E) as a professor of public policy at Duke  
15 University;

16 (F) as President of Duke University;

17 (G) as a United States Senator from  
18 North Carolina;

19 (H) as a patron of the arts; and

20 (I) as a loving and committed husband and  
21 father.

22 (2) Terry Sanford fought tirelessly and self-  
23 lessly throughout his life to improve the lives of his  
24 fellow citizens through public education, racial heal-  
25 ing, economic development, eradication of poverty,  
26 and promotion of the arts.

1           (3) Terry Sanford exemplified the best qualities  
2           mankind has to offer.

3           (4) Terry Sanford lived an exemplary life and  
4           is owed a debt of gratitude for his untiring service  
5           to the State of North Carolina and his fellow Ameri-  
6           cans.

7   **SEC. 3. DESIGNATION.**

8           The Federal building located at 310 New Bern Ave-  
9           nue in Raleigh, North Carolina, shall be known and des-  
10          ignated as the “Terry Sanford Federal Building”.

11   **SEC. 4. REFERENCES.**

12          Any reference in law, map, regulation, document,  
13          paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal  
14          building referred to in section 3 shall be deemed to be  
15          a reference to the “Terry Sanford Federal Building”.

16   **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

17          *The Federal building located at 310 New Bern Avenue*  
18          *in Raleigh, North Carolina, shall be known and designated*  
19          *as the “Terry Sanford Federal Building”.*

20   **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

21          *Any reference in law, map, regulation, document,*  
22          *paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal*  
23          *building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a*  
24          *reference to the “Terry Sanford Federal Building”.*
