- 5 (a) Repeal.—Section 1103 of title 38, United States
- 6 Code, is repealed.

- 1 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
- 2 at the beginning of chapter 11 of such title is amended
- 3 by striking the item relating to section 1103.
- 4 SEC. 2. FUNDS NOT REQUIRED TO BE OFFSET FROM OTHER
- 5 **PROGRAMS.**
- 6 Upon the enactment of this Act, the Director of the
- 7 Office of Management and Budget shall not make any es-
- 8 timate of changes in direct spending outlays under section
- 9 252(d) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit
- 10 Control Act of 1985 for any fiscal year resulting from the
- 11 enactment of this Act.
