- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINES.
- 4 Notwithstanding the time limitations of section 13 of
- 5 the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806), the Federal En-

- 1 ergy Regulatory Commission, upon the request of the li-
- 2 censee for FERC Project No. 10455 (and after reasonable
- 3 notice), is authorized, in accordance with the good faith,
- 4 due diligence and public interest requirements of section
- 5 13 and the Commission's procedures under such section,
- 6 to extend the time required for commencement of con-
- 7 struction of the project for up to a maximum of 3 consecu-
- 8 tive 2-year periods. This section shall take effect for the
- 9 project upon the expiration of the extension (issued by the
- 10 Commission under section 13) of the period required for
- 11 commencement of such project.
