AN ACT

To make available to the Ukrainian Museum and Archives the USIA television program "Window on America".

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. AVAILABILITY OF USIA TELEVISION PROGRAM

- 2 "WINDOW ON AMERICA".
- 3 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding section 208 of
- 4 the Foreign Relations Authorization Act, Fiscal Years
- 5 1986 and 1987 (22 U.S.C. 1461–1a) and the second sen-
- 6 tence of section 501 of the United States Information and
- 7 Educational Exchange Act of 1948 (22 U.S.C. 1461), the
- 8 Director of the United States Information Agency is au-
- 9 thorized to make available, upon request, to the Ukrainian
- 10 Museum and Archives in Cleveland, Ohio and the Slavics
- 11 Collection, Indiana University Libraries in Bloomington,
- 12 Indiana, copies of the television program "Window on
- 13 America" produced by the WORLDNET Television Serv-
- 14 ice of the United States Information Agency.
- 15 (b) LIMITATION.—The Ukrainian Museum and Ar-
- 16 chives and the Slavics Collection are prohibited from
- 17 broadcasting any materials made available pursuant to
- 18 this Act.
- 19 (c) Reimbursement.—The Ukrainian Museum and
- 20 Archives and the Slavics Collection shall reimburse the Di-
- 21 rector of the United States Information Agency for any
- 22 expenses involved in making such copies available. Any re-
- 23 imbursement to the Director pursuant to this subsection
- 24 shall be credited to the applicable appropriation of the
- 25 United States Information Agency.

- 1 (d) Termination.—Subsection (a) shall cease to
- 2 have effect 5 years after the date of the enactment of this
- 3 Act.
