### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Airport Environmental

5 and Community Fairness Act".

### 6 SEC. 2. ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT REQUIRED.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Granting of any additional slot8 for operation of air service at LaGuardia Airport in New

York shall be considered to be a major Federal action sig nificantly affecting the quality of the human environment
for purposes of section 102(2)(C) of the National Environ mental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4332(2)(C)).

5 (b) SLOTS REVOKED.—Order 97–10–17 of the Sec-6 retary of Transportation entitled "Order granting and de-7 nying applications for slot exemptions at New York's 8 LaGuardia Airport" and order 98–4–22 of the Secretary 9 entitled "Order granting and denying applications for slot 10 exemptions at New York's LaGuardia and John F. Ken-11 nedy Airports" are invalid and shall have no force or ef-12 fect.

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
