## A BILL

To authorize the use of receipts from the sale of the Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamps to promote additional stamp purchases.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Migratory Bird Hunt-
- 5 ing and Conservation Stamp Promotion Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. PROMOTION OF STAMP SALES.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 4 of the Act of March 16,
- 8 1934 (chapter 71; 16 U.S.C. 718d), popularly known as
- 9 the Migratory Bird Hunting Stamp Act, is amended—
