2 This Act may be cited as the "NATO Special Immi-3 grant Amendments of 1998". 4 SEC. 2. SPECIAL IMMIGRANT STATUS FOR CERTAIN NATO 5 **CIVILIAN EMPLOYEES.** 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 101(a)(27) of the Immi-7 gration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101(a)(27)) is 8 amended-(1) by striking "or" at the end of subparagraph 9 10 (J), 11 (2) by striking the period at the end of subparagraph (K) and inserting "; or", and 12 13 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-14 paragraph: 15 "(L) an immigrant who would be described in 16 clause (i), (ii), (iii), or (iv) of subparagraph (I) if 17 any reference in such a clause— "(i) to an international organization de-18 19 scribed in paragraph (15)(G)(i) were treated as 20 a reference to the North Atlantic Treaty Orga-21 nization (NATO); "(ii) to a nonimmigrant under paragraph 22 23 (15)(G)(iv) were treated as a reference to a 24 nonimmigrant classifiable under NATO-6 (as a 25 member of a civilian component accompanying 26 a force entering in accordance with the provi-
