1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. INCREASE DISCRETIONARY FUNDING FOR CER-**
2 **TAIN GRANT PROGRAMS ESTABLISHED**
3 **UNDER THE “EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL**
4 **STATE AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AS-**
5 **SISTANCE PROGRAMS”.**

6 Section 1001(a) of the Omnibus Crime Control and
7 Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3793(a)) is amended
8 by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

9 “(24) There is authorized to be appropriated
10 \$50,000,000 for fiscal year 1998 to carry out sub-
11 part 2 of part E of this title.”.
