A BILL

To amend the Veterans' Benefits Improvement Act of 1996 to eliminate the requirement that members of the Commission on Servicemembers and Veterans Transition Assistance be allocated to separate programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Commission on
5 Servicemembers and Veterans Transition Assistance Im-
6 provement Act of 1997".

7 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF ALLOCATED DUTIES.**

8 (a) TRANSITION ASSISTANCE.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 702(b)(1) of the
2 Veterans’ Benefits Improvement Act of 1996 (Public
3 Law 104–275, 38 U.S.C. 545 note) is amended to
4 read as follows: “(1) The Commission shall review
5 programs intended to assist members of the Armed
6 Forces at the time of their separation from service
7 in the Armed Forces, including programs designed
8 to assist families of such members.”.

9 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
10 702(b)(2) of such Act is amended, in the matter
11 preceding subparagraph (A), by striking out “those
12 members of”.

13 (b) BENEFITS PROGRAMS.—

14 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 702(c)(1) of such
15 Act is amended, in the matter preceding subpara-
16 graph (A), to read as follows: “(1) The Commission
17 shall review the following programs:”.

18 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
19 702(c)(2) of such Act is amended by striking out
20 “such members of”.
