## A BILL

To amend the General Education Provisions Act to allow State and county prosecutors access to student records in certain cases.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROTECTION OF THE RIGHTS AND PRIVACY OF**  
4 **PARENTS AND STUDENTS.**

5 Section 444(b) of the General Education Provisions  
6 Act (20 U.S.C. 1221) is amended by adding at the end  
7 the following:

8 “(7) Nothing in this section shall be construed  
9 to require a State or county prosecutor to obtain a  
10 court order to receive student information, before or

1 after adjudication, if the information sought pertains  
2 to a criminal investigation or prosecution of such  
3 student.”.
