## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide a minimum mandatory penalty for conveying false bomb threats through instrumentalities of interstate and foreign commerce.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “False Bomb Threat  
5 Penalty Act of 1997”.

**1 SEC. 2. FALSE BOMB THREATS.**

2 Section 844(e) of title 18, United States Code, is  
3 amended by striking “for not more than” and all that fol-  
4 lows through “, or both.” and inserting “for not less than  
5 one year nor more than 10 years and fined under this  
6 title.”.
