3 **SECTION 1. DELAY IN COMMENCEMENT OF REPAYMENT**
4 **PERIOD.**

5 Section 428(b)(7) of the Higher Education Act of
6 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1078(b)(7)) is amended by inserting
7 after subparagraph (C) the following new subparagraph:

1 “(D) There shall be excluded from the 6
2 months determined under subparagraph (A)(i) any
3 period during which the student was called or or-
4 dered to active duty in a reserve component of the
5 Armed Forces of the United States.”.

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
