IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

NOVEMBER 7, 1997

Ms. PRYCE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of certain resolutions in preparation for the adjournment of the first session sine die.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House a joint resolu-
3 tion waiving certain enrollment requirements with respect
4 to certain specified bills of the One Hundred Fifth Con-
5 gress. The joint resolution shall be considered as read for
6 amendment. The previous question shall be considered as
7 ordered on the joint resolution to final passage without
8 intervening motion except: (1) One hour of debate equally

1 divided and controlled by the majority leader and the mi-
2 nority leader or their designees; and (2) one motion to
3 commit.

4 SEC. 2. Upon the adoption of this resolution it shall
5 be in order to consider in the House a joint resolution
6 appointing the day for the convening of the second session
7 of the One Hundred Fifth Congress. The joint resolution
8 shall be considered as read for amendment. The previous
9 question shall be considered as ordered on the joint resolu-
10 tion to final passage without intervening motion except:
11 (1) One hour of debate equally divided and controlled by
12 the majority leader and the minority leader or their des-
13 ignees; and (2) one motion to commit.

14 SEC. 3. The Speaker, the majority leader, and the
15 minority leader may accept resignations and make ap-
16 pointments to commissions, boards, and committees fol-
17 lowing the adjournment of the first session sine die as au-
18 thorized by law or by the House.

19 SEC. 4. A resolution providing that a committee of
20 two Members of the House be appointed to wait upon the
21 President of the United States and inform him that the
22 House of Representatives has completed its business of the
23 session and is ready to adjourn, unless the President has
24 some other communication to make to them, is hereby
25 adopted.

1 SEC. 5. A concurrent resolution providing that the
2 two Houses of Congress assemble in the Hall of the House
3 of Representatives on Tuesday, January 27, 1998, at 9
4 p.m., for the purpose of receiving such communication as
5 the President of the United States shall be pleased to
6 make to them is hereby adopted.

7 SEC. 6. House Resolution 306 is laid on the table.
