RESOLUTION

Regarding the bill S. 1150, the Agricultural Research, Extension, and Education Reauthorization Act of 1998.

1 Resolved, That upon adoption of this resolution the House shall be considered to have: 3 (1) taken from the Speaker's table the bill (S. 1150 entitled "An Act to ensure that federally fund-4 5 ed agricultural research, extension, and education 6 address high-priority concerns with national or 7 multistate significance, to reform, extend, and elimi-8 nate certain agricultural research programs, and for 9 other purposes";

1 (2) struck out all after the enacting clause of
2 the bill S. 1150 and inserted in lieu thereof an
3 amendment consisting of the text of the bill (H.R.
4 2534) entitled "An Act to reform, extend, and repeal
5 certain agricultural research, extension, and edu6 cation programs, and for other purposes", as passed
7 by the House;

- (3) passed the bill S. 1150 as amended; and
- (4) insisted on the House amendment and requested a conference with the Senate thereon.
