RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H. J. Res. 111) proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States with respect to tax limitations.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the joint reso-
3 lution (H. J. Res. 111) proposing an amendment to the
4 Constitution of the United States with respect to tax limi-
5 tations. The joint resolution shall be considered as read
6 for amendment. The amendment specified in the report

1 of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution
2 shall be considered as adopted. The previous question shall
3 be considered as ordered on the joint resolution, as amend-
4 ed, and on any further amendment thereto to final passage
5 without intervening motion except: (1) three hours of de-
6 bate on the joint resolution, as amended, which shall be
7 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
8 ing minority member of the Committee on the Judiciary;
9 (2) one motion to amend, if offered by the Minority Lead-
10 er or his designee, which shall be considered as read and
11 shall be separately debatable for one hour equally divided
12 and controlled by the proponent and an opponent; and (3)
13 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
