Providing for consideration of certain resolutions in preparation for the adjournment of the second session sine die.

IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

OCTOBER 13, 1998

Mr. SOLOMON, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of certain resolutions in preparation for the adjournment of the second session sine die.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House a joint resolu-
3 tion appointing the day for the convening of the first ses-
4 sion of the One Hundred Sixth Congress. The joint resolu-
5 tion shall be considered as read for amendment. The pre-
6 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the joint
7 resolution to final passage without intervening motion ex-
8 cept: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and controlled

1 by the Majority Leader and the Minority Leader or their
2 designees; and (2) one motion to commit.

3 SEC. 2. A resolution providing that any organiza-
4 tional caucus or conference in the House of Representa-
5 tives for the One Hundred Sixth Congress may begin on
6 or after November 18, 1998, is hereby adopted.

7 SEC. 3. A resolution providing for the printing of a
8 revised edition of the Rules and Manual of the House of
9 Representatives for the One Hundred Sixth Congress as
10 a House document, and for the printing and binding of
11 three thousand additional copies for the use of the House,
12 of which nine hundred copies shall be bound in leather
13 with thumb index and delivered as may be directed by the
14 Parliamentarian of the House, is hereby adopted.

15 SEC. 4. A resolution providing that a committee of
16 two Members of the House be appointed to wait upon the
17 President of the United States and inform him that the
18 House of Representatives has completed its business of the
19 session and is ready to adjourn, unless the President has
20 some other communication to make to them, is hereby
21 adopted.

22 SEC. 5. The Speaker, the Majority Leader, and the
23 Minority Leader may accept resignations and make ap-
24 pointments to commissions, boards, and committees fol-

1 lowing the adjournment of the second session sine die as
2 authorized by law or by the House.

3 SEC. 6. The chairman and ranking minority member
4 of each standing committee and subcommittee may extend
5 their remarks in the Congressional Record and include a
6 summary of the work of their committee or subcommittee.
