3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR**
4 **REFUGEE AND ENTRANT ASSISTANCE.**

5 (a) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Section
6 414(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
7 1524(a)) is amended by striking “fiscal year 1995, fiscal
8 year 1996, and fiscal year 1997” and inserting “each of
9 fiscal years 1998 and 1999”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) shall take effect October 1, 1997.
