To suspend temporarily the duty on a certain chemical.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.32.15	2,3-xylenesulfonamide, 5-amino-N-(2-hydroxyethyl) (CAS No. 25797-78-8) (provided for in subheading 2935.00.95)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2000	”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 this section applies to articles entered, or withdrawn from
