Mr. MOYNIHAN (for himself and Mr. GRASSLEY) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Labor and Human Resources

A BILL

To amend the National Narcotics Leadership Act of 1988 to establish qualification standards for individuals nominated to be the Deputy Director of Demand Reduction in the Office of National Drug Control Policy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. QUALIFICATIONS FOR DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF**
4 **DEMAND REDUCTION IN OFFICE OF NA-**
5 **TIONAL DRUG CONTROL POLICY.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1003(a)(1) of the Na-
7 tional Narcotics Leadership Act of 1988 (21 U.S.C.
8 1502(a)(1)) is amended—

1 (1) by inserting “(A)” after “(1)”;

2 (2) by striking “the Deputy Directory for De-
3 mand Reduction,”; and

4 (3) by adding at the end the following:

5 “(B) The Deputy Director for Demand Reduc-
6 tion shall be appointed by the President, by and with
7 the advice and consent of the Senate, from among
8 individuals who—

9 (i) have a scientific educational and pro-
10 fessional background;

11 (ii) are eminent in the field of substance
12 abuse treatment or substance abuse prevention;
13 and

14 (iii) have a demonstrated record of pro-
15 fessional publication and research in a sub-
16 stance abuse discipline.”.

17 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by sub-
18 section (a) shall only apply to individuals nominated under
19 section 1003(a)(1)(B) of the National Narcotics Leader-
20 ship Act of 1988 on or after the date of enactment of
21 this Act.
