## A BILL

1 SECTION 1. EXCLUSION OF ADDITIONAL RESERVE COMPO-2 NENT GENERAL AND FLAG OFFICERS FROM 3 LIMITATION ON NUMBER OF GENERAL AND 4 FLAG OFFICERS WHO MAY SERVE ON ACTIVE 5 DUTY. 6 Section 526(d) of title 10, United States Code, is 7 amended to read as follows: "(d) EXCLUSION OF CERTAIN RESERVE 8 Offi-

9 CERS.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the limitations of 10 this section do not apply to the following reserve compo-11 nent general or flag officers:

12 "(A) A general or flag officer who is on active13 duty for training.

14 "(B) A general or flag officer who is on active
15 duty under a call or order specifying a period of less
16 than 180 days.

17 "(C) A general or flag officer who is on active
18 duty under a call or order specifying a period of
19 more than 179 days.

"(2) The number of general or flag officers of an
armed force covered by paragraph (1)(C) at any one time
may not exceed the number equal to three percent of the
number specified for that armed force under subsection
(a).".
