AN ACT

For the relief of Marin Turcinovic, and his fiancée, Corina
Dechalup.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
3 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
4 1101 et seq.), Marin Turcinovic and his fiancée, Corina
5 Dechalup, shall be held and considered to have been law-
6 fully admitted to the United States for permanent resi-
7 dence as of the date of the enactment of this Act upon
8 payment of the required visa fees.

9 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

10 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Marin
11 Turcinovic and his fiancée, Corina Dechalup, as provided
12 in this Act, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper
13 officer to reduce by the appropriate number during the
14 current fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas
15 available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth
16 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
17 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
