A BILL

For the relief of Marin Turcinovic, and his fiancée, Corina Dechalup.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
6 1101 et seq.), Marin Turcinovic and his fiancée, Corina
7 Dechalup, shall be held and considered to have been law-
8 fully admitted to the United States for permanent resi-

1 dence as of the date of the enactment of this Act upon
2 payment of the required visa fees.

3 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

4 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Marin
5 Turcinovic and his fiancée, Corina Dechalup, as provided
6 in this Act, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper
7 officer to reduce by the appropriate number during the
8 current fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas
9 available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth
10 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
11 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
