Mr. Campbell introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend chapter 61 of title 5, United States Code, to make election day a legal public holiday, with such holiday to be known as "Freedom and Democracy Day".

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FINDINGS.
- 4 The Congress finds that—
- 5 (1) democratic government derives its legit-
- 6 imacy from the consent of the governed, as mani-
- 7 fested in the full participation of an informed and
- 8 aware electorate;

- 1 (2) since 1960 the rate of voter participation in 2 the United States has declined and is now among 3 the lowest of any nation with a democratic form of 4 government;
 - (3) since 1972 the rate of voter participation among young people in the United States has declined significantly;
 - (4) the Federal Government should encourage personal responsibility and the broader understanding of the value and importance of the right to vote; and
- 12 (5) the establishment of a legal public holiday 13 on election day, the first Tuesday after the first 14 Monday in November of each even numbered year, 15 could provide a substantial incentive to increase 16 voter participation by the American public.

17 SEC. 2. SENSE OF THE CONGRESS.

It is the sense of the Congress that educators, civic and charitable organizations, radio and television broadcasters, and public officials at all levels of government should help the people of the United States celebrate Freedom and Democracy Day through appropriate celebrations and events which stress the importance of self-government.

SEC. 3. DESIGNATION OF ELECTION DAY AS LEGAL PUBLIC

2 HOLIDAY. 3 Section 6103 of title 5, United States Code, is 4 amended— 5 (1) by redesignating subsection (d) as sub-6 section (e); and 7 (2) by inserting after subsection (c) the follow-8 ing: 9 "(d)(1) Subject to paragraph (2), the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in each even num-10 bered year, Election Day, shall be a legal public holiday, 11 with such holiday to be known as Freedom and Democracy 13 Day. 14 "(2) Freedom and Democracy Day— "(A) shall be a regular workday; 15 16 "(B) shall not be treated as a legal public holi-17 day for purposes of statutes relating to pay and 18 leave of employees as defined by section 2105 of this 19 title; and "(C) shall not affect the regular operations of 20 21 the Federal Government.".
