A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on shadow mask steel.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY DUTY-FREE TREATMENT FOR IM-**
4 **PORTS OF SHADOW MASK STEEL.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new headings:

“	9902.72.09	Of a thickness of less than 0.361mm (backplate), of a kind for use in making aperture masks for cathode-ray tube video displays (provided for in subheading 7209.18.25)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 1/1/2001
---	------------	---	------	-----------	-----------	-----------------------

9902.72.11	Of a thickness not exceeding 0.25mm, of a kind for use in making aperture masks for cathode-ray tube video displays (provided for in subheading 7211.23.60)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 1/1/2001	”.
9902.72.25	Of a width of 600mm or more of a kind for use in making aperture masks for cathode-ray tube video displays (provided for in subheading 7225.50.80)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 1/1/2001	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
2 this section applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of enactment of this Act.
