1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress makes the following find-3 ings:

4 (1) Senator Strom Thurmond of South Carolina 5 first became a member of the Committee on Armed Services of the United States Senate on January 19, 6 7 1959. His continuous service on that committee cov-8 ers more than 75 percent of the period of the exist-9 ence of the committee, which was established imme-10 diately after World War II, and more than 20 per-11 cent of the period of the existence of military and 12 naval affairs committees of Congress, the original 13 bodies of which were formed in 1816.

(2) Senator Thurmond came to Congress and
the committee as a distinguished veteran of service,
including combat service, in the Armed Forces of the
United States.

18 (3) Senator Thurmond was commissioned as a 19 reserve second lieutenant of infantry in 1924. He 20 served with great distinction with the First Army in 21 the European Theater of Operations during World 22 War II, landing in Normandy in a glider with the 23 82nd Airborne Division on D-Day. He was trans-24 ferred to the Pacific Theater of Operations at the 25 end of the war in Europe and was serving in the 26 Philippines when Japan surrendered.
