A BILL

A bill to clarify the application of the Unfunded Mandates Reform Act of 1995, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FEDERAL INTERGOVERNMENTAL MANDATE.**

4 Section 421(5)(B) of the Congressional Budget and
5 Impoundment Control Act of 1974 (2 U.S.C. 658(5)(B))
6 is amended—

7 (1) by striking “the provision” after “if”;

8 (2) in clause (i)(I) by inserting “the provision”
9 before “would”;

1 (3) in clause (i)(II) by inserting “the provision”
2 before “would”; and

3 (4) in clause (ii)—

4 (A) by inserting “that legislation, statute,
5 or regulation does not provide” before “the
6 State”; and

7 (B) by striking “lack” and inserting “new
8 or expanded”.
