## A BILL

To allow all States to participate in activities under the Education Flexibility Partnership Demonstration Act.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Education Flexibility
- 5 Amendments of 1998".
- 6 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.
- 7 Congress makes the following findings:
- 8 (1) States differ substantially in demographics,
- 9 in level of urbanization, in geography, and in school

1	governance. The administrative and funding mecha-
2	nisms that help schools in 1 State improve may not
3	prove successful in other States.
4	(2) State and local educational agencies are re-
5	quired to complete numerous reporting requirements
6	established by Federal rule or regulation. States and
7	schools need flexibility, with respect to Federal and
8	State rules and regulations, to devise the best way
9	in differing situations to achieve the goals of Federal
10	and State education laws.
11	(3) To achieve the State goals for the education
12	of children in the State, the focus must be on re-
13	sults, not process.
14	(4) Activities assisted under the Education
15	Flexibility Partnership Demonstration Act, as imple-
16	mented by 12 States—
17	(A) represent a significant step in focusing
18	on results not process; and
19	(B) give States substantial flexibility in ex-
20	change for accountability.
21	SEC. 3. EXPANSION OF THE EDUCATION FLEXIBILITY PART
22	NERSHIP DEMONSTRATION ACT.
23	(a) In General.—Section 311(e) of the Goals 2000
24	Educate America Act (20 U.S.C. 5891(e)) is amended—
25	(1) in paragraph (2)—

1	(A) by amending subparagraph (A) to read
2	as follows:
3	"(A) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary may
4	carry out an education demonstration program
5	under which the Secretary authorizes—
6	"(i) a State educational agency that
7	serves an eligible State to waive statutory
8	or regulatory requirements applicable to 1
9	or more programs or Acts described in
10	subsection (b), other than requirements de-
11	scribed in subsection (c), for the State edu-
12	cational agency or any local educational
13	agency or school within the State; and
14	"(ii) a State educational agency that
15	serves an eligible State and participated in
16	the program under this subsection prior to
17	the date of enactment of the Education
18	Flexibility Amendments of 1998 to waive
19	statutory or regulatory requirements appli-
20	cable to 1 or more programs or Acts de-
21	scribed in subsection (b), title III of the
22	Elementary and Secondary Education Act
23	of 1965, or the Adult Education Act, other
24	than requirements described in subsection
25	(c), for the State educational agency or

1	any local educational agency or school
2	within the State.";
3	(B) by striking subparagraph (B); and
4	(C) by redesignating subparagraph (C) as
5	subparagraph (B); and
6	(2) in paragraph (3)—
7	(A) in subparagraph (A), by inserting "(i)"
8	after "(A)";
9	(B) in subparagraph (B), by striking the
10	period and inserting "; or";
11	(C) by redesignating subparagraph (B) (as
12	amended by subparagraph (B)) as clause (ii);
13	and
14	(D) by adding at the end the following:
15	"(B) has a consolidated State plan or a
16	consolidated State application approved by the
17	Secretary under section 14302 of the Elemen-
18	tary and Secondary Education Act of 1965.".
19	(b) Funding.—Section 311(e) of the Goals 2000:
20	Educate America Act (20 U.S.C. 5891(e)) is amended fur-
21	ther by adding at the end the following:
22	"(h) Funding.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
23	sion of law and using any funds available to the Secretary,
24	the Secretary shall make available such funds as are nec-

- 1 essary to carry out this subsection for each of the fiscal
- 2~ years 1999 through 2003.".
