A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide an increase in the lifetime learning education credit for expenses of teachers in improving technology training.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. INCREASED LIFETIME LEARNING CREDIT FOR

4 TECHNOLOGY TRAINING OF ELEMENTARY
5 AND SECONDARY TEACHERS.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 25A(c) of the Internal
7 Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to lifetime learning credit)
8 is amended by adding at the end the following new para9 graph:

1	"(3) Special rule for technology train-
2	ING OF CERTAIN TEACHERS.—If any portion of the
3	qualified tuition and related expenses to which this
4	subsection applies—
5	"(A) are paid or incurred by an individual
6	who is a kindergarten through grade 12 teacher
7	in an elementary or secondary school, and
8	"(B) are incurred as part of a program
9	which is approved and certified by the appro-
10	priate local educational agency as directly relat-
11	ed to improvement of the individual's capacity
12	to use technology in teaching,
13	paragraph (1) shall be applied with respect to such
14	portion by substituting '50 percent' for '20 per-
15	cent'."
16	(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
17	this section shall apply to expenses paid after December
18	31, 1998, for education furnished in academic periods be-
19	ginning after such date.

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
