A BILL

To amend the Older Americans Act of 1965 to extend the authorizations of appropriations for that Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATIONS OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

4 (a) FEDERAL COUNCIL ON THE AGING.—Section
5 204(g) of the Older Americans Act of 1965 (42 U.S.C.
6 3015(g)) is amended by striking “\$300,000 for fiscal year
7 1992 and such sums as may be necessary for fiscal years

1 1993, 1994, and 1995” and inserting “such sums as may
2 be necessary for fiscal years 1999 through 2001”.

3 (b) ADMINISTRATION.—Section 215 of such Act (42
4 U.S.C. 3020f) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “fiscal years
6 1992, 1993, 1994, and 1995” and inserting “fiscal
7 years 1999 through 2001”; and

8 (2) in subsection (b), by striking paragraph (1)
9 and inserting the following:

10 “(1) \$29,000,000 for each of fiscal years 1999
11 through 2001; and”.

12 (c) GRANTS FOR STATE AND COMMUNITY PROGRAMS
13 ON AGING.—Section 303 of such Act (42 U.S.C. 3023)
14 is amended—

15 (1) in subsection (a)(1), by striking
16 “\$461,376,000 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums
17 as may be necessary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and
18 1995” and inserting “such sums as may be nec-
19 essary for fiscal years 1999 through 2001”;

20 (2) in subsection (b)—

21 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking
22 “\$505,000,000 for fiscal year 1992 and such
23 sums as may be necessary for fiscal years 1993,
24 1994, and 1995” and inserting “such sums as

1 may be necessary for fiscal years 1999 through
2 2001”;

3 (B) in paragraph (2), by striking
4 “\$120,000,000 for fiscal year 1992 and such
5 sums as may be necessary for fiscal years 1993,
6 1994, and 1995” and inserting “such sums as
7 may be necessary for fiscal years 1999 through
8 2001”; and

9 (C) in paragraph (3), by striking
10 “\$15,000,000 for fiscal year 1992 and such
11 sums as may be necessary for fiscal years 1993,
12 1994, and 1995” and inserting “such sums as
13 may be necessary for fiscal years 1999 through
14 2001”;

15 (3) in subsection (d), by striking “\$45,388,000
16 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums as may be nec-
17 essary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and
18 inserting “such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
19 years 1999 through 2001”;

20 (4) in subsection (e), by striking “the fiscal
21 years 1992, 1993, 1994, and 1995” and inserting
22 “fiscal years 1999 through 2001”;

23 (5) in subsection (f), by striking “\$25,000,000
24 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums as may be nec-
25 essary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and

1 inserting “such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
2 years 1999 through 2001”; and

3 (6) in subsection (g), by striking “\$15,000,000
4 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums as may be nec-
5 essary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and
6 inserting “such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
7 years 1999 through 2001”.

8 (d) AVAILABILITY OF SURPLUS COMMODITIES.—Sec-
9 tion 311(c)(1)(A) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 3030a(c)(1)(A))
10 is amended by striking “\$250,000,000 for fiscal year
11 1992, \$310,000,000 for fiscal year 1993, \$380,000,000
12 for fiscal year 1994, and \$460,000,000 for fiscal year
13 1995” and inserting “\$460,000,000 for each of fiscal
14 years 1999 through 2001”.

15 (e) TRAINING, RESEARCH, AND DISCRETIONARY
16 PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS.—Section 431 of such Act (42
17 U.S.C. 3037) is amended—

18 (1) in subsection (a)(1), by striking
19 “\$72,000,000 for fiscal year 1992, and such sums
20 as may be necessary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and
21 1995” and inserting “such sums as may be nec-
22 essary for fiscal years 1999 through 2001”; and

23 (2) in subsection (b), by striking “\$450,000 for
24 each of fiscal years 1992, 1993, 1994, and 1995”

1 and inserting “\$450,000 for each of fiscal years
2 1999 through 2001”.

3 (f) COMMUNITY SERVICE EMPLOYMENT FOR OLDER
4 AMERICANS.—Section 508(a)(1) of such Act (42 U.S.C.
5 3056f(a)(1)) is amended by striking “\$470,671,000 for
6 fiscal year 1992, and such sums as may be necessary for
7 fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and inserting “such
8 sums as may be necessary for fiscal years 1999 through
9 2001”.

10 (g) GRANTS FOR NATIVE AMERICANS.—Section
11 633(a) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 3057n(a)) is amended by
12 striking “\$30,000,000 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums
13 as may be necessary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and
14 1995” and inserting “such sums as may be necessary for
15 fiscal years 1999 through 2001”.

16 (h) ALLOTMENTS FOR VULNERABLE ELDER RIGHTS
17 PROTECTION ACTIVITIES.—Section 702 of such Act (42
18 U.S.C. 3058a) is amended—

19 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “\$40,000,000
20 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums as may be nec-
21 essary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and
22 inserting “such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
23 years 1999 through 2001”;

24 (2) in subsection (b), by striking “\$15,000,000
25 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums as may be nec-

1 essary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and
2 inserting “such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
3 years 1999 through 2001”;

4 (3) in subsection (c), by striking “\$10,000,000
5 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums as may be nec-
6 essary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and
7 inserting “such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
8 years 1999 through 2001”; and

9 (4) in subsection (d), by striking “\$15,000,000
10 for fiscal year 1992 and such sums as may be nec-
11 essary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and
12 inserting “such sums as may be necessary for fiscal
13 years 1999 through 2001”.

14 (i) NATIVE AMERICAN PROGRAM.—Section 751(d) of
15 such Act (42 U.S.C. 3058aa(d)) is amended by striking
16 “\$5,000,000 for fiscal year 1992, and such sums as may
17 be necessary for fiscal years 1993, 1994, and 1995” and
18 inserting “such sums as may be necessary for fiscal years
19 1999 through 2001”.

20 **SEC. 2. TRANSFERS.**

21 Section 308(b) of the Older Americans Act of 1965
22 (42 U.S.C. 3028(b)) is amended—

23 (1) in paragraph (4)(B)—

1 (A) by striking “fiscal year 1993, 1994,
2 1995, or 1996” and inserting “a fiscal year”;
3 and

4 (B) by striking “need—” and all that fol-
5 lows and inserting “need, an additional 10 per-
6 cent of the funds so received for the fiscal
7 year.”; and

8 (2) in paragraph (5)—

9 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “not
10 more than 30 percent for fiscal year 1993, not
11 more than 25 percent for fiscal year 1994, not
12 more than 25 percent for fiscal year 1995, and
13 not more than 20 percent for fiscal year 1996”
14 and inserting “not more than 20 percent for
15 the fiscal year involved”; and

16 (B) in subparagraph (B)—

17 (i) by striking “(B)(i)” and all that
18 follows through “(ii) If” and inserting
19 “(B) If”; and

20 (ii) by striking “for fiscal year 1996”
21 and inserting “for a fiscal year”.
