# **AN ACT**

To establish the National Cave and Karst Research Institute in the State of New Mexico, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "National Cave and5 Karst Research Institute Act of 1997".

## 1 SEC. 2. PURPOSES.

2	The purposes of this Act are—
3	(1) to further the science of speleology;
4	(2) to centralize and standardize speleological
5	information;
6	(3) to foster interdisciplinary cooperation in
7	cave and karst research programs;
8	(4) to promote public education;
9	(5) to promote national and international co-
10	operation in protecting the environment for the ben-
11	efit of cave and karst landforms; and
12	(6) to promote and develop environmentally
13	sound and sustainable resource management prac-
14	tices.
15	SEC. 3. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE INSTITUTE.
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#### 1 SEC. 4. ADMINISTRATION OF THE INSTITUTE.

2 (a) MANAGEMENT.—The Institute shall be jointly ad3 ministered by the National Park Service and a public or
4 private agency, organization, or institution, as determined
5 by the Secretary.

6 (b) GUIDELINES.—The Institute shall be operated 7 and managed in accordance with the study prepared by 8 the National Park Service pursuant to section 203 of the 9 Act entitled "An Act to conduct certain studies in the 10 State of New Mexico", approved November 15, 1990 11 (Public Law 101–578; 16 U.S.C. 4310 note).

(c) CONTRACTS AND COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS.—
The Secretary may enter into a contract or cooperative
agreement with a public or private agency, organization,
or institution to carry out this Act.

16 (d) FACILITY.—

17 (1) LEASING OR ACQUIRING A FACILITY.—The
18 Secretary may lease or acquire a facility for the In19 stitute.

20 (2) CONSTRUCTION OF A FACILITY.—If the
21 Secretary determines that a suitable facility is not
22 available for a lease or acquisition under paragraph
23 (1), the Secretary may construct a facility for the
24 Institute.

25 (e) ACCEPTANCE OF GRANTS AND TRANSFERS.—To
26 carry out this Act, the Secretary may accept—

(1) a grant or donation from a private person;
 or

3 (2) a transfer of funds from another Federal4 agency.

## 5 SEC. 5. FUNDING.

6 (a) MATCHING FUNDS.—The Secretary may spend
7 only such amount of Federal funds to carry out this Act
8 as is matched by an equal amount of funds from non-Fed9 eral sources.

10 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
11 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as may be
12 necessary to carry out this Act.
