Mr. CHAFEE (for himself, Mr. BAUCUS, Mr. BREAUX, and Mr. COCHRAN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

A BILL

To authorize the use of receipts from the sale of migratory bird hunting and conservation stamps to promote additional stamp purchases.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Migratory Bird Hunt-
5 ing and Conservation Stamp Promotion Act of 1998”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROMOTION OF STAMP SALES.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 4 of the Act of March 16,
8 1934 (commonly known as the “Migratory Bird Hunting

1 and Conservation Stamp Act”) (16 U.S.C. 718d), is
 2 amended—

3 (1) in subsection (b), by striking “subsection
 4 (c) of this section” and inserting “subsections (c)
 5 and (d)”; and

6 (2) by adding at the end the following:

7 “(d) PROMOTION OF STAMP SALES.—

8 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to approval of an
 9 annual marketing plan by the Migratory Bird Con-
 10 servation Commission established by section 2 of the
 11 Migratory Bird Conservation Act (16 U.S.C. 715a),
 12 the Secretary of the Interior may use from receipts
 13 from the sale of migratory bird hunting and con-
 14 servation stamps an amount not to exceed
 15 \$1,000,000 for each of fiscal years 1999 through
 16 2003 for the promotion of additional stamp sales.

17 “(2) ANNUAL REPORT.—The Secretary of the
 18 Interior shall—

19 “(A) include in each report under section
 20 3 of the Migratory Bird Conservation Act (16
 21 U.S.C. 715b) a statement of all expenditures
 22 under paragraph (1); and

23 “(B) provide a copy to the Migratory Bird
 24 Conservation Commission, the Committee on
 25 Environment and Public Works of the Senate,

1 and the Committee on Resources of the House
2 of Representatives.”.

3 (b) TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS.—

4 (1) SHORT TITLE.—

5 (A) The Act of March 16, 1934 (16 U.S.C.
6 718 et seq.), is amended by adding at the end
7 the following:

8 **“SEC. 11. SHORT TITLE.**

9 “This Act may be cited as the ‘Migratory Bird Hunt-
10 ing and Conservation Stamp Act’.”.

11 (B) Section 4(d)(2) of the National Wild-
12 life Refuge System Administration Act of 1966
13 (16 U.S.C. 668dd(d)(2)) is amended in the last
14 sentence by striking “Migratory Bird Hunting
15 Stamp Act” and inserting “Migratory Bird
16 Hunting and Conservation Stamp Act”.

17 (C) Section 102 of the Sikes Act (16
18 U.S.C. 670b) is amended by striking “Migra-
19 tory Bird Hunting Stamp Act as amended” and
20 inserting “Migratory Bird Hunting and Con-
21 servation Stamp Act (16 U.S.C. 718 et seq.)”.

22 (D) Section 203(b)(4)(A) of the Sikes Act
23 (16 U.S.C. 670i(b)(4)(A)) is amended by strik-
24 ing “Act of March 16, 1934, commonly referred
25 to as the Migratory Bird Hunting Stamp Act”

1 and inserting “Migratory Bird Hunting and
2 Conservation Stamp Act”.

3 (E) Section 2 of Public Law 87–383 (16
4 U.S.C. 715k–4) is amended by striking “Migra-
5 tory Bird Hunting Stamp Act of March 16,
6 1934, as amended” and inserting “Migratory
7 Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp Act”.

8 (F) Section 201 of the Emergency Wet-
9 lands Resources Act of 1986 (16 U.S.C. 3911)
10 is amended—

11 (i) in subsection (b)(1)(A), by striking
12 “Act of March 16, 1934 (16 U.S.C. 718b)
13 (commonly known as the Duck Stamp
14 Act)” and inserting “Migratory Bird
15 Hunting and Conservation Stamp Act (16
16 U.S.C. 718b)”; and

17 (ii) in subsection (c)(B), by striking
18 “Act of March 16, 1934” and inserting
19 “Migratory Bird Hunting and Conserva-
20 tion Stamp Act”.

21 (G) Section 203 of the Emergency Wet-
22 lands Resources Act of 1986 (16 U.S.C. 3912)
23 is amended by striking “Act of March 16,
24 1934” and inserting “Migratory Bird Hunting
25 and Conservation Stamp Act”.

(H) Clause (ii) of section 504(1) of title 18, United States Code, is amended by striking “Migratory Bird Hunting Stamp Act of 1934” and inserting “Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp Act (16 U.S.C. 718 et seq.)”.

(I) Section 28(f) of the Act of August 13, 1954 (25 U.S.C. 564w–1(f) is amended—

(i) in the second sentence, by striking “Migratory Bird Hunting Stamp Act of March 16, 1934, as amended (16 U.S.C. 718)” and inserting “Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp Act (16 U.S.C. 718 et seq.)”; and

(ii) in the third sentence, by striking “section 4 of the Act of March 16, 1934 (48 Stat. 451), as amended or supplemented” and inserting “section 4 of the Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp Act (16 U.S.C. 718d)”.

(2) MIGRATORY BIRD HUNTING AND CONSERVATION STAMP.—

(A) The first section and section 10 of the Act of March 16, 1934 (16 U.S.C. 718a, 718j), are amended by striking “migratory-bird hunt-

1 ing and conservation stamp” each place it ap-
2 pears and inserting “migratory bird hunting
3 and conservation stamp”.

4 (B) Section 2(a) of the Act of March 16,
5 1934 (16 U.S.C. 718b(a)), is amended in the
6 fifth sentence by striking “migratory-bird hunt-
7 ing stamps” and inserting “migratory bird
8 hunting and conservation stamps”.

9 (C) Sections 4(a) and 5(c) of the Act of
10 March 16, 1934 (16 U.S.C. 718d(a), 718e(c)),
11 are amended by striking “migratory bird hunt-
12 ing stamps” each place it appears and inserting
13 “migratory bird hunting and conservation
14 stamps”.

15 (D) Section 5(a) of the Act of March 16,
16 1934 (16 U.S.C. 718e(a)), is amended by strik-
17 ing “migratory-bird hunting stamp” and insert-
18 ing “migratory bird hunting and conservation
19 stamp”.

20 (E) Section 2(4) of the Act of September
21 28, 1962 (16 U.S.C. 460k–1(4)), is amended by
22 striking “migratory bird hunting stamps” and
23 inserting “migratory bird hunting and conserva-
24 tion stamps”.

1 (F) Section 203(b)(4)(A) of the Sikes Act
2 (16 U.S.C. 670i(b)(4)(A)) is amended by strik-
3 ing “migratory bird hunting stamp” and insert-
4 ing “migratory bird hunting and conservation
5 stamp”.

6 (G) Section 3(a) of the Act of July 30,
7 1956 (16 U.S.C. 718b–1), is amended by strik-
8 ing “migratory-bird hunting stamps” and in-
9 serting “migratory bird hunting and conserva-
10 tion stamps”.
