**A BILL**

To authorize the use of receipts from the sale of migratory bird hunting and conservation stamps to promote additional stamp purchases.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Migratory Bird Hunt-  
5 ing and Conservation Stamp Promotion Act of 1998”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROMOTION OF STAMP SALES.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 4 of the Act of March 16,  
3 1934 (commonly known as the “Migratory Bird Hunting  
4 and Conservation Stamp Act”) (16 U.S.C. 718d), is  
5 amended—

6 (1) in subsection (b), by striking “subsection  
7 (c) of this section” and inserting “subsections (c)  
8 and (d)”; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(d) PROMOTION OF STAMP SALES.—

11 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to approval of an  
12 annual marketing plan by the Migratory Bird Con-  
13 servation Commission established by section 2 of the  
14 Migratory Bird Conservation Act (16 U.S.C. 715a),  
15 the Secretary of the Interior may use from receipts  
16 from the sale of migratory bird hunting and con-  
17 servation stamps an amount not to exceed  
18 \$1,000,000 for each of fiscal years 1999 through  
19 2003 for the promotion of additional stamp sales.

20 “(2) ANNUAL REPORT.—The Secretary of the  
21 Interior shall—

22 “(A) include in each report under section  
23 3 of the Migratory Bird Conservation Act (16  
24 U.S.C. 715b) a statement of all expenditures  
25 under paragraph (1); and

1           “(B) provide a copy to the Migratory Bird  
2           Conservation Commission, the Committee on  
3           Environment and Public Works of the Senate,  
4           and the Committee on Resources of the House  
5           of Representatives.”.

6           (b) TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS.—

7           (1) SHORT TITLE.—

8           (A) The Act of March 16, 1934 (16 U.S.C.  
9           718 et seq.), is amended by adding at the end  
10          the following:

11       **“SEC. 11. SHORT TITLE.**

12           “‘This Act may be cited as the ‘Migratory Bird Hunt-  
13          ing and Conservation Stamp Act’.”.

14           (B) Section 4(d)(2) of the National Wild-  
15          life Refuge System Administration Act of 1966  
16          (16 U.S.C. 668dd(d)(2)) is amended in the last  
17          sentence by striking “Migratory Bird Hunting  
18          Stamp Act” and inserting “Migratory Bird  
19          Hunting and Conservation Stamp Act”.

20           (C) Section 102 of the Sikes Act (16  
21          U.S.C. 670b) is amended by striking “Migra-  
22          tory Bird Hunting Stamp Act as amended” and  
23          inserting “Migratory Bird Hunting and Con-  
24          servation Stamp Act (16 U.S.C. 718 et seq.)”.

1 (D) Section 203(b)(4)(A) of the Sikes Act  
2 (16 U.S.C. 670i(b)(4)(A)) is amended by strik-  
3 ing “Act of March 16, 1934, commonly referred  
4 to as the Migratory Bird Hunting Stamp Act”  
5 and inserting “Migratory Bird Hunting and  
6 Conservation Stamp Act”.

7 (E) Section 2 of Public Law 87–383 (16  
8 U.S.C. 715k–4) is amended by striking “Migra-  
9 tory Bird Hunting Stamp Act of March 16,  
10 1934, as amended” and inserting “Migratory  
11 Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp Act”.

12 (F) Section 201 of the Emergency Wet-  
13 lands Resources Act of 1986 (16 U.S.C. 3911)  
14 is amended—

15 (i) in subsection (b)(1)(A), by striking  
16 “Act of March 16, 1934 (16 U.S.C. 718b)  
17 (commonly known as the Duck Stamp  
18 Act)” and inserting “Migratory Bird  
19 Hunting and Conservation Stamp Act (16  
20 U.S.C. 718b)”; and

21 (ii) in subsection (c)(B), by striking  
22 “Act of March 16, 1934” and inserting  
23 “Migratory Bird Hunting and Conserva-  
24 tion Stamp Act”.

1 (G) Section 203 of the Emergency Wet-  
2 lands Resources Act of 1986 (16 U.S.C. 3912)  
3 is amended by striking “Act of March 16,  
4 1934” and inserting “Migratory Bird Hunting  
5 and Conservation Stamp Act”.

6 (H) Clause (ii) of section 504(1) of title  
7 18, United States Code, is amended by striking  
8 “Migratory Bird Hunting Stamp Act of 1934”  
9 and inserting “Migratory Bird Hunting and  
10 Conservation Stamp Act (16 U.S.C. 718 et  
11 seq.)”.

12 (I) Section 28(f) of the Act of August 13,  
13 1954 (25 U.S.C. 564w-1(f) is amended—

14 (i) in the second sentence, by striking  
15 “Migratory Bird Hunting Stamp Act of  
16 March 16, 1934, as amended (16 U.S.C.  
17 718)” and inserting “Migratory Bird  
18 Hunting and Conservation Stamp Act (16  
19 U.S.C. 718 et seq.)”; and

20 (ii) in the third sentence, by striking  
21 “section 4 of the Act of March 16, 1934  
22 (48 Stat. 451), as amended or supple-  
23 mented” and inserting “section 4 of the  
24 Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation  
25 Stamp Act (16 U.S.C. 718d)”.

1           (2) MIGRATORY BIRD HUNTING AND CONSERVA-  
2           TION STAMP.—

3           (A) The first section and section 10 of the  
4           Act of March 16, 1934 (16 U.S.C. 718a, 718j),  
5           are amended by striking “migratory-bird hunt-  
6           ing and conservation stamp” each place it ap-  
7           pears and inserting “migratory bird hunting  
8           and conservation stamp”.

9           (B) Section 2(a) of the Act of March 16,  
10          1934 (16 U.S.C. 718b(a)), is amended in the  
11          fifth sentence by striking “migratory-bird hunt-  
12          ing stamps” and inserting “migratory bird  
13          hunting and conservation stamps”.

14          (C) Sections 4(a) and 5(c) of the Act of  
15          March 16, 1934 (16 U.S.C. 718d(a), 718e(c)),  
16          are amended by striking “migratory bird hunt-  
17          ing stamps” each place it appears and inserting  
18          “migratory bird hunting and conservation  
19          stamps”.

20          (D) Section 5(a) of the Act of March 16,  
21          1934 (16 U.S.C. 718e(a)), is amended by strik-  
22          ing “migratory-bird hunting stamp” and insert-  
23          ing “migratory bird hunting and conservation  
24          stamp”.

1           (E) Section 2(4) of the Act of September  
2           28, 1962 (16 U.S.C. 460k-1(4)), is amended by  
3           striking “migratory bird hunting stamps” and  
4           inserting “migratory bird hunting and conserva-  
5           tion stamps”.

6           (F) Section 203(b)(4)(A) of the Sikes Act  
7           (16 U.S.C. 670i(b)(4)(A)) is amended by strik-  
8           ing “migratory bird hunting stamp” and insert-  
9           ing “migratory bird hunting and conservation  
10          stamp”.

11          (G) Section 3(a) of the Act of July 30,  
12          1956 (16 U.S.C. 718b-1), is amended by strik-  
13          ing “migratory-bird hunting stamps” and in-  
14          serting “migratory bird hunting and conserva-  
15          tion stamps”.
