3 "SEC. 8. ACQUISITION OF WARREN PROPERTY FOR MOR4 RISTOWN NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK.

5 "(a) IN GENERAL.—In addition to any other land or interest authorized to be acquired for inclusion in the Mor-6 7 ristown National Historical Park, and notwithstanding the 8 first proviso of the first section of this Act, the Secretary 9 of the Interior may acquire by purchase, donation, or 10 other means not to exceed 15 acres of land and interests in land comprising the property known as the Warren 11 Property' or 'Mount Kemble'. 12

13 "(b) AUTHORIZED EXPENDITURE.—The Secretary
14 may expend such sums as are necessary for the acquisi15 tion.

16 "(c) ADMINISTRATION.—Any land or interest ac17 quired under this section shall be included in and adminis18 tered as part of the Morristown National Historical
19 Park.".
