Mr. Graham (for himself and Mr. Mack) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

# A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to make technical corrections to a map relating to the Coastal Barrier Resources System.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FINDINGS AND PURPOSE.
- 4 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds that—
- 5 (1) Coastal Barrier Resources System unit FL-
- 6 35P was designated under the Coastal Barrier Im-
- 7 provement Act of 1990 (Public Law 101–591) to in-
- 8 clude Florida State conservation land within the
- 9 Coastal Barrier Resources System;

- 1 (2) unit FL-35P is an "otherwise protected 2 area", a designation that was intended to include 3 land held for conservation purposes;
  - (3) the boundary of unit FL-35P runs through a portion of the Ocean Reef Harbor Course South development, which was in existence on the date of enactment of the 1990 Act;
  - (4) at the time unit FL-35P was designated, 9 residences were located in the portion of the development that was included within the boundaries of the unit;
  - (5) the 11.7 acres comprising that portion are not held for conservation purposes, and are not an inholding within conservation land;
  - (6) the United States Fish and Wildlife Service has received certificates of occupancy and corresponding plat maps from Monroe County, Florida, verifying that a portion of unit FL–35P was developed, and accordingly that the portion referred to in paragraph (5) was mistakenly included in the Coastal Barrier Resources System; and
  - (7) modification of the boundary of unit FL–35P to exclude the 11.7-acre parcel referred to in paragraph (5) would constitute a valid technical correction.

- 1 (b) Purpose.—The purpose of this Act is to make
- 2 a technical correction to unit FL-35P of the Coastal Bar-
- 3 rier Resources System to exclude from the unit the 11.7-
- 4 acre parcel of developed property that was mistakenly in-
- 5 cluded in the unit.

#### 6 SEC. 2. CORRECTIONS TO MAP.

- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the
- 8 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Interior
- 9 shall make such corrections to the map described in sub-
- 10 section (b) as are necessary to ensure that depictions of
- 11 areas on the map are consistent with the depictions of
- 12 areas appearing on the map entitled "Amendments to the
- 13 Coastal Barrier Resources System", dated August 31,
- 14 1998, and on file with the Secretary.
- 15 (b) Map Described.—The map described in this
- 16 subsection is the map that—
- 17 (1) is included in a set of maps entitled "Coast-
- al Barrier Resources System", dated October 24,
- 19 1990; and
- 20 (2) relates to unit FL-35P of the Coastal Bar-
- 21 rier Resources System.

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
