3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
6 1101 et seq.), Wei Jengsheng shall be held and considered
7 to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for

permanent residence as of the date of the enactment of
 this Act upon payment of the required visa fee.

3 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.

4 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Wei 5 Jengsheng as provided in this Act, the Secretary of State 6 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by one during 7 the current fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas 8 available to natives of the country of the alien's birth 9 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality 10 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).

11 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for purposes of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
1101 et seq.), Wei Jingsheng shall be held and considered
to have been lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent residence as of the date of the enactment of this
Act upon payment of the required visa fee.

18 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.

19 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Wei 20 Jingsheng as provided in this Act, the Secretary of State 21 shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by one during the 22 current fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas 23 available to natives of the country of the alien's birth under 24 section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 25 U.S.C. 1153(a)). Amend the title so as to read: "For the relief of Wei Jingsheng.".
