## A BILL

To designate the United States courthouse located in Paducah, Kentucky, as the “Edward Huggins Johnstone United States Courthouse”.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4       The United States courthouse located in Paducah,  
5       Kentucky, shall be known and designated as the “Edward  
6       Huggins Johnstone United States Courthouse”.

7       **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

8       Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
9       paper, or other record of the United States to the United  
10      States courthouse referred to in section 1 shall be deemed
